The recent refugee crisis has several geographical hot spots - one is located in the Mediterranean between the coast of North African, Malta and Italy. Refugees from the Middle East and Sub-Saharan Africa try to reach in small boats European territory. Thousands pay this ride with their lives. To offer a humanitarian help to those who otherwise would potentially lose their lives in these not seaworthy boats, on 9 May this year civil society representatives from different countries (like Germany, Italy and France), came together in Berlin to create the European Association for the Rescue of Life in the Mediterranean Sea - SOS Mediterranean! (https://sosmediterranee.org/). Since then this NGO has collected funds - among others via Crowdfunding (https://www.ulule.com/sosmed/)- to buy a 60-meters long former Dutch pilot ship, which is currently renovated in a shipyard in Croatia. This autumn it will start its route along the coast of North Africa. The mid-term aim is to create a European-wide network of similar initiatives, in support for Doctors of the World (https://www.doctorsoftheworld.org.uk/). To discuss this project with the Brussels-based stakeholders, Klaus Vogel, the captain of the ship has accepted to come to the capital of Europe (https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=03NhESLMtR4). To show their solidarity, Residence Palace-Intl press center and Choux de Bruxelles, Residence Palace's catering partner (this Art Deco building from the 20ies) have offered their premises for this event free of charge - in addition the profit of selling drinks during the evening will go directly to the Foundation SOS Mediterranean.
